International Service has proposed Club's consideration to areas falling within the RI and RIBI priorities. In order not to "deluge" Clubs, these have been restricted to four fund-raising projects and the suggestion of two further which create no fund raising.

Fund Raising - These are: (a)- The Lombok Water Filter Project (near Bali) led by RC Heathfield and Waldron (Ron Willis); (b) The Yellowmen of Kadongdong Project to reduce child mortality (currently at 67%) in NW Kenya led by RC Senlac; (c) An ambulance for Juri (Bangladesh) to alleviate severe and long-term health transport problems, led by RC Langley Park and (d) Adult-Learning in Northern Peru, a village at Cajamarca where currently there is none and much deprivation. These cover water, health, child mortality and literacy with, of course, poverty having a role within each.

Non-Fund Raising - These are: "Tools for Self Reliance" and Vision Aid for spectacles.
